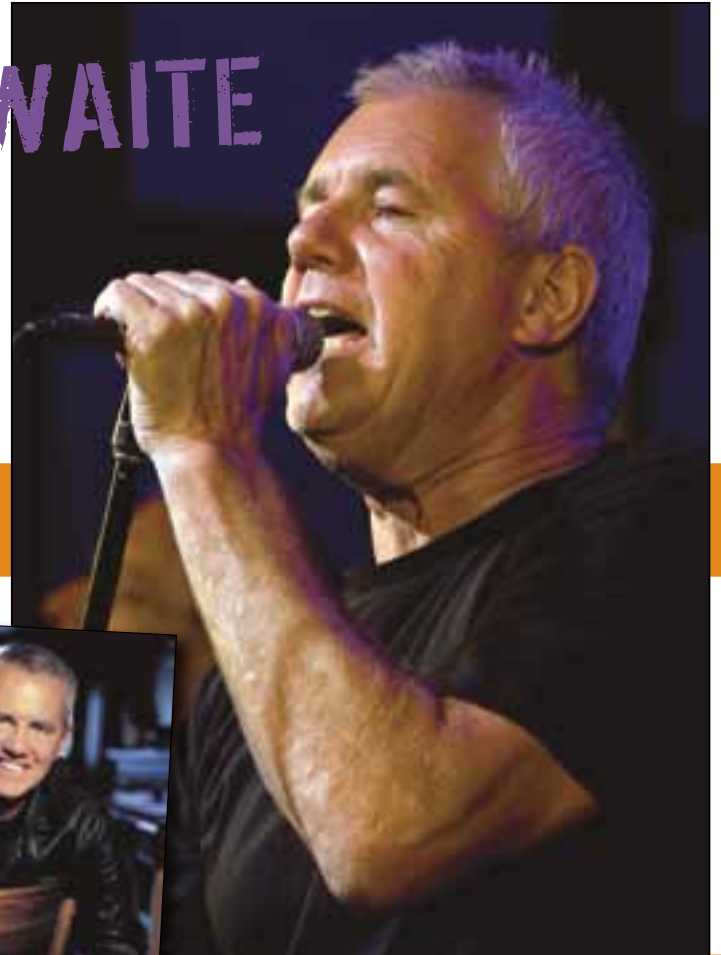
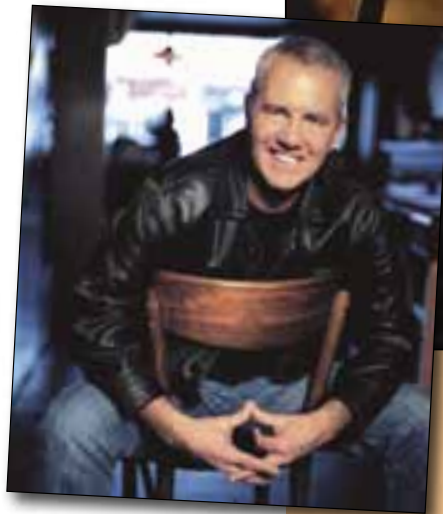

Well, pruning is finally done! Around 30,000 vines were hand pruned over June, July and August. As the weather finally warms up we watch anxiously as BUD BURST begins! It is a very exciting time, especially for those involved with winter pruning as when cutting and tying down is done the vines are dormant and appear very much dead. However, come spring time they reassure us that they are very much alive and well and begin their growing season with the period called BUD BURST. The buds swell then leaves and shoots emerge which will become the new canes for this year's fruit. We hope for a warm and extended summer which will give high yield and quality fruit at vintage in April.
